If the average death investigation takes an average of 5.0 hours to investigate, complete a report, telephone calls, record review, meetings and follow up and the Office investigates approximately 800 cases annually, that equals approximately 4000 hours. Then on the average, the Office would require 4 full time Deputy Coroners

800 cases x 5.0 hours = 4000 hours on average Some investigations may require less/more hours depending on the type of investigation Natural, Accident, Suicide, Homicide, Undetermined

VACATIONS - depending on longevity, vacation time will be longer, thus subtracting more time off from normal work hrs
